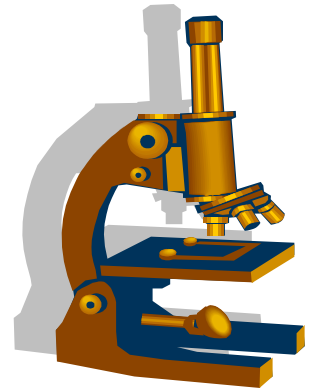

IMPORTANT TESTING DATES NEXT WEEK!

A reminder to the parents of 3rd-6th graders that we will be doing **SBA testing** on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday next week, April 7th, 8th, 9th.

Parking Lot Safety

DROP OFF PROCEDURE

When dropping off your child at the curbside of either building please make sure that he/she is able to exit the vehicle on his/her own. If you are unable to do this, please park your car in the parking lot and walk him/her in.

PICK UP PROCEDURE

When picking up your child, park your car in the parking lot and go into the gym/multi-purpose room to pick him/her up.

DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE PARKED AT THE CURB at anytime during the school day. This interrupts traffic flow, creates safety issues and interferes with deliveries / pick-ups.

Park only in the designated areas between the blue barrels. DO NOT PARK BE-SIDE THE BUILDINGS, NEAR THE PLAYGROUND OR BEYOND THE OUTER-MOST BLUE BARRELS. When vehicles are not where they should be accidents are sure to happen. We have had a few close calls.

SWIMMING CLASSES AVAILABLE!!

We have the opportunity to be included in the Community Schools Swimming Lesson Program at Palmer Pool during the last two weeks of April. We need a minimum of 40 students to participate for us to qualify. This will include a bus to pick up the kids for two weeks (4 days each week/ Mon-Thurs) after school. You will be responsible for picking up your child at the Palmer Pool at 4:30-4:45 P.M. each day. The class lasts 45 minutes. The cost is \$60.

We also need two adult volunteers to commit to the two weeks: One to ride the bus to the pool and one to pick up that person & bring them back to their car. You do not have to stay for the class. These volunteers each receive two sheets of free swim passes.

Preschoolers, that are at least four years old, are welcome but parents must be present. It is also recommended that they have had prior experience in the pool.
