



Fronteras Spanish Immersion Charter School Kindergarten/First Grade School Supply List, 2010-2011

- 1 backpack -** labeled clearly with your child's name **(must be large enough to accommodate a notebook and school books and should come to school daily)**
- 1 pair gym shoes -** (also labeled) **need not be new but must be the correct size and non-marking on the gym floor - THESE NEED TO STAY AT SCHOOL**
- 1 box of snacks** (crackers, fruit snacks, dried fruit, pretzels) to be used in case of emergency when lunches are forgotten or an emergency strikes.
- Snow clothing** (won't come to school until weather dictates): warm jacket, hat, gloves or mittens, snow pants and insulated boots.
- Change of Clothing** Each student should have a change of underwear, socks, and outer pants in a Ziploc bag. This will be stored in his/her backpack in case of need.

Please do not label the following items. They will be gathered to be used by the whole class. Please explain the idea of sharing these items before your child brings them to school. We may be pooling our supplies this year to accommodate their use in class.

- 2 wide rule spiral notebooks (70 page variety)
- 2 pink erasers
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white liquid glue
- 1 small box of crayons
- 1 box of 8 basic Crayola fat washable markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of watercolor paints (Crayola & Prang are good - Mead is not)
- 1 vinyl ("Pee-Chee" type) folder with pockets inside - no rings. (If you get the vinyl folder for homework, you will not have to replace it . . . it will last the whole year!)
- 6 glue sticks
- 3 audio CD's
- 3 Bic black (thin line) outlining marker

Boys:

- 1 box sandwich Ziplocs,
- 1 package of wet wipes,
- 10-12 regular pencils (sharpened please,
- 1 package plastic spoons, plastic forks or white paper plates

Girls:

- 1 box quart Ziplocs,
- 1 box tissues,
- 1 package disinfectant wipes,
- 1 package of clear, plastic tumblers (the short sturdy ones, please)
